LETTERS FROM BISHOP GREGORY AND MOTHER MONA-MARIE BEJJANI

Dear Father Simon:

John Kurey and I just returned from Lebanon where I saw our friend, Monsignor Sami Hayek. Monsignor Sami served for over 50 years in our Maronite parishes in America and now lives in a retirement home run by the Missionary Sisters of the Very Holy Sacrament, a congregation of women religious who do wonderful work for children, the poor, senior citizens and women struggling in their lives. I am aware that you and your parishioners have done much to help the Missionary Sisters. Thank you very much for this.

The Sisters have several needs that they are seeking assistance with: new cars to replace the three cars they have that are each over30 years old and have over 200,000 miles on them; repairs to the home they run for poor senior citizens; school busses to bring students from 30 surrounding villages to their school; and finishing construction of a medical clinic that will assist the poor with basic medical care. Each of these items costs a lot – a minimum of \$25,000.

I would like to ask for your continued help in finding or inspiring some donors who may be willing to help the Sisters with any of these needs or with some smaller needs, such as purchasing equipment for the kitchen that serves their students. This equipment is to be used to train some students in trades such as cooking and baking, and may also be used to help make a small profit from food and dessert sales made with this equipment to help pay some costs of the school.

Father Simon, if you could please think of who in your area might be well disposed towards helping these wonderful Sisters with these needs, I would be very grateful again to you.

Dear Father El Haii,

I would like to thank you and your parish for the help you have generously provided to us in the past. It has meant so much to us. I am also aware of your kindness to Monsignor Sami Hayek who resides in our retirement home in Kfarmassoun. Thank you for this too. Monsignor Hayek is a great friend and we are blessed to have him here with us.

As you know, our congregation was founded in 1966. Our mission includes schools, pastoral activities, training in practical skills for young women (such as sewing, embroidery and cooking), taking care of elderly women, and operating medical clinics to serve the poorest of the poor. These activities take place in our congregation's eight convents, most of which are located in rural regions of Lebanon. I would like to ask for your help with our current need for a few critical pieces of kitchen equipment for our main convent and school that serves 1,325 Students from 30 surrounding villages, including 85 residential students.

Please find attached descriptions of these items that will serve our students and Sisters. We would be most grateful if you could inspire some of your parishioners or friends to support any of these projects. These items will help us to better serve the poor and needy, and may also help reduce our future needs. Thank you for considering our needs once again.
