As some of you may have heard, there will be a permanent Lebanese Heritage exhibition in downtown Easton at the Sigal Museum located at 342 Northampton Street, near Our Lady of Lebanon Church.

This exhibit will be made possible through the efforts of Dr. Andrea Smith and the Lafayette College Mellon Grant, as well as the Northampton County Historical and Genealogical Society/Sigal Museum.

If you are Lebanese or of Lebanese descent and your ancestors resided or you reside in Northampton County please continue to read the following:

In order for this project to be successful and inclusive, I'm in need of everyone's support and help. This is a collective project that requires the participation of all.

Any photographs and artifacts loaned to the museum for a semi-permanent/extended period of time will depend on you and the time you wish to donate the item for. A contract between the Sigal Museum and the loaner will be signed at the time of delivery.

Photos and videos will be copied, scanned, digitized and returned to owner as soon as the process is completed. All this will be done through a reputable professional company to make sure items are returned to owners in the same condition.

Artifacts will be on display with a short description of the item underneath it and the name of the loaner. As insignificant as an object might seem to you, sometimes it is the most valuable to me.

Oral histories will be transcribed as time allows. Please contact me directly if you would like to set up an interview appointment. This process is very time consuming so I'm trying to get started as soon as possible.

I'm also interested, not only in the early life of Lebanese in Easton but also in its continuity until today. I would like to hear from all of you about your personal/family experience. The best way to share this is to write it yourselves and I will try my best to incorporate it into the exhibition.

Please feel free to share your story if you have a job, a title or an accomplishment to show the progression of our people from the 1900's until today.

I am representing the Sigal Museum in this project so please feel free to call, text, message or email me at anytime. Leave me a message with your info and I will try to get back to you in a timely manner.

Generations of future Lebanese-Americans will appreciate your efforts to preserve their heritage!
