

Order of Saint Sharbel Sunday



Sunday, October 7th is designated as Holy Rosary Sunday. We will be praying the Rosary 30 minutes before Saturday's and Sunday's Liturgy for world peace.

The first clear historical reference to the rosary is from the life of St. Dominic (died in 1221), the founder of the Order of Preachers or Dominicans. Tradition has it that the Blessed Mother herself asked for the practice as an antidote for heresy and sin.

One of Dominic's future disciples, Alain de Roche, began to establish Rosary Confraternities to promote the praying of the rosary. The form of the rosary we have today is believed to date from his time. Over the centuries the saints and popes have highly recommended the rosary, the greatest prayer in the Church after the Mass and Liturgy of the Hours.

Rosary means a *crown of roses*, a spiritual bouquet given to the Blessed Mother. While the hands and lips are occupied with the prayers the mind meditates on the mysteries of the Incarnation and Redemption represented by the decades In this way the heart, mind, and soul of the Christian is formed according to the Gospel examples of the Savior and His First Disciple, His Mother.
