DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY 2021 at ST. JANE'S

On **April 11**th, St. Jane's Parish will celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, an extension of Easter Sunday's Joy - described by Jesus Himself as the Feast to be considered as "the last hope of salvation". During this dramatic time of epidemic, we pray earnestly for God's Mercy on all humanity, threatened with sickness and death, and for all our medical personnel, medical researchers and all workers who stand on the "frontline" of this virulent war. Jesus has promised: "**You will not be alone, because I am with you always and everywhere. Near to My Heart, fear nothing."** (Diary of Divine Mercy, 797) We should never consider ourselves as people without hope! The central aspiration at the heart of the Divine Mercy Devotion exclaims: "**Jesus, I Trust in You!**"

The Divine Mercy Holy Hour, **beginning at 3:00pm**, with Eucharistic Adoration, is centered on the singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and the glorious celebration of Benediction. (Confessions will be heard on Saturday, April 10th from 3:45 – 4:45pm, before the 5:00 pm Mass & on Sunday, April 11th, from 2:00-2:45PM before the Holy Hour begins.) Join with all Catholics around the world on this great Easter feast day of the new millennium, reminding us that **Mercy is God's other Name!**
