

## **BEGINNING OF THE LITURGICAL YEAR**

The Maronite Church's liturgical calendar and lectionary follows that of the Syro-Antiochene Christian tradition and is based on the stages of the life of Our Lord Jesus Christ: his birth, public ministry, passion, death, resurrection, and looks forward to his return in glory.


The Maronite liturgical calendar consists of six seasons and begins with the Sunday of the Consecration of the Church on the 1st Sunday of November and ends with the Season of the Holy Cross in September in accordance with the Syro-Antiochene tradition.

Please also be aware of the Holy Days of Obligation. The faithful are bound by the obligation to participate in the liturgy on certain Holy Days of Obligation that may fall on a week day.

- 1. The Nativity of the Lord on December 25
- 2. The Circumcision of Our Lord on January 1
- 3. The Glorious Epiphany (Baptism) of Our Lord on January 6
- 4. The Feast of St. Maron on February 9
- 5. The Ascension of the Lord 40 days after Resurrection Sunday (Easter)
- 6. The Assumption of Our Lady on August 15
- 7. The Feast of All Saints on November 1
- 8. The Immaculate Conception of Our Lady on December 8

Also be aware that all Sundays are Holy Days of Obligation. Christians are obligated to commit to going to church on every Sunday of the year, for it was on Sunday that Our Lord rose from the dead and trampled death by death. Therefore, as we say in the Maronite liturgy, he "exalted Sunday far above all days."

All Sundays, then, are feast days and days of rest and one should not fast on a Sunday, even during Great Lent, but recall our Lord's resurrection and our salvation. Failing to attend liturgy on a Sunday and not having a valid excuse, such as being ill or needed to care for someone who is ill, is a sin and must be absolved through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
