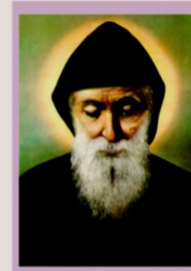

An Urgent Plea from Bishop Gregory

The situation in Debel has reached a critical point.

- ◆ Approximately 1,800 civilians remain trapped in the area
- ◆ Supply access has been declining for months, with zero deliveries in the past few weeks.
- ◆ Local grocery stores are nearly empty
- ◆ No fresh food (including fruits and vegetables) is entering the area
- ◆ No access to medical care
- ◆ Essential medicines are running out
- ◆ Severe shortages of basic hygiene products
- ◆ Residents are surviving on stored grains and well water

This is no longer a developing crisis - it is an emergency. Without immediate intervention, conditions will continue to worsen rapidly.
