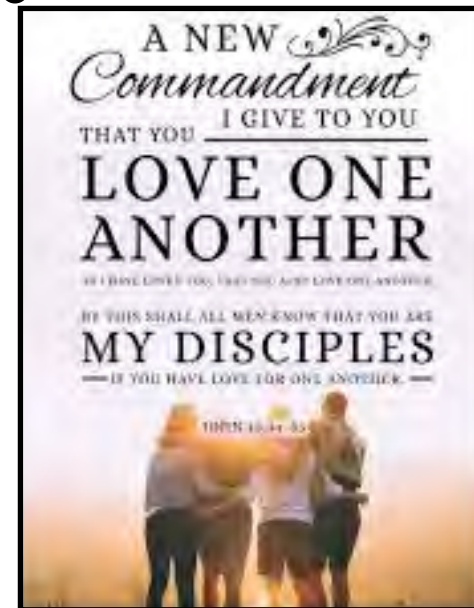

**An Urgent Plea from Bishop Gregory**

The situation in Debel has reached a critical point.

- ♦ Approximately 1,800 civilians remain trapped in the area
- ♦ Supply access has been declining for months, with zero deliveries in the past few weeks.
- ♦ Local grocery stores are nearly empty
- ♦ No fresh food (including fruits and vegetables) is entering the area
- ♦ No access to medical care
- ♦ Essential medicines are running out
- ♦ Severe shortages of basic hygiene products
- ♦ Residents are surviving on stored grains and well water

This is no longer a developing crisis - it is an emergency. Without immediate intervention, conditions will continue to worsen rapidly.
